Do you know how the Apostle Peter rescued from the prison by an Angel...?



SAINT OF THE DAY

The Inspiring Life of Blessed Carlo Acutis

(The First Millennial Saint- Patron of the Youth and internet)



Dear Friends, today we will introduce you about a young little saint. Carlo Acutis was born in London on May 3rd 1991, grew up Milan, in Italy. As a child he stood out for his joy, generosity and great love for God. He said that the Eucharist was his 'highway to heaven'. He went to Holy mass and prayed the Rosary every day. He never missed Eucharistic adoration before or after the mass. He participated in volunteer works as his friends loved him very much. At the age of 7, he first received Holy Communion. When he was 11 years old, he received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Carlo was friendly and his attitude and his words left a mark on those who met him. No one remained indifferent. Everyone in the neighbourhood knew him. At lunch he would bring the leftover food in a container for the homeless people. He was a normal teenager who strived to be the best version of himself, living the ordinary in an extraordinary way. He would donate money to the Capuchins, who served lunches for the homeless. He used the advice of Mother Teresa to help those who are in need around him.

Purity was very important to Carlo. Each person reflects the light of God. It hurts him when his classmates did not live according to Christian morals. He would encourage them to do

so, trying to help them understand that the human body is a gift from God. He knew how to use the communication technology to transmit the Gospel, to communicate the values and beauty.

As a young teenager, He enjoyed putting on his diving goggles and playing, fetch trash from the bottom of the sea. when he took the dogs out for a work, he always picked up whatever garbage he came across. It was his way of keeping the environment clean. He used to say: (What's the use of winning 1000 battles if you can't beat your own passions?).

He was very talented with computers and programming. He studied manuals and apps and used these to evangelize in internet. He is best known for documenting Eucharistic miracles around the world and cataloguing them onto a website. He took the role of a messenger to spread his faith, love for God and Eucharistic through internet in a good way.

Carlo died October 12th 2006 at the age of 15 with Leukemia. Carlo's witness to the Gospel is not only an inspiration for the young youth and children, but it also helps parish priests and teachers to question themselves about the value of the formation they give to young people of parish.

Carlo lived a life of grace and shared his experience of God with his peers. He was attracted by the friendship of Christ. He lived his life without wasting even a minute on anything unpleasing to God. He was Beatified by Pope Francis on 10th October 2020.

So dear friends we can also fellow the model of young Carlo to serve God without wasting our time in playing on gadgets, instead we can use the technologies as our good messenger.
